

BLOCK PARTY REGULATIONS

Your Canton Police Department is happy to comply with your request for barricading a public street in order for you and your neighbors to participate in a block party; however, you must follow the rules listed below for the protection of lives and property:

- ⇒ The street is not to be barricaded with any immovable objects such as motor vehicles, trailers, etc. You must use lightweight wooden barricades. Please call Canton DPW at 734-394-5150 four (4) days to your scheduled event to make arrangements to pick up the barricades. The Canton DPW office is located at 4847 Sheldon Road.
- ⇒ Place the wooden barricades at each end of the block. ***Do not block the street in any manner that would prevent emergency vehicles from having ready access to any home or injured person.*** Barricades need to be taken down at the end of the event and returned to DPW the next business day.
- ⇒ Notify ***all*** residents in the party area that they ***cannot*** drive to and from their houses during the block party; they should move their vehicles to another location prior to the start of the party if access is required.
- ⇒ **Fireworks use is prohibited - use of such will exclude future block parties.**
- ⇒ Canton residents need to adhere to all noise ordinance requirements. Disturbance calls to the Police Department will jeopardize future requests for block parties.

- Fifty-one percent (51%) or more of affected homeowners must sign the petition in favor of the block party.
- You must submit your petition and completed Request Form to the Canton Police Department, Community Relations Sergeant, no later than the Friday two weeks prior to your request. Final instructions will be sent to you within one week.
